


Song Kwang-Ik 宋光翼



Song Kwang-Ik (b. 1950) was born in Korea and holds B.F.A. and Ed.A. degrees from Keimyung University in Daegu, Korea; and studied at Graduate Seminar Art College at Kyushu Sangyo University in Fukuoka, Japan. By applying or scattering paint on paper, Song's artworks resemble a sense of nature and history. Hanji, or Korean paper, is made from the inner bark of paper mulberry; such material preserves the energy of wind and sunlight that engenders life. In Song's artworks, every piece of hanji resonates with each other and thus creates unique vibrations between the gaps; while depending on one's viewpoint and exhibition space, the multiple layers of hanji transform into infinite lines and planes. His works are recently exhibited in Tong-in Auction Gallery, Gallery Shilla, and Bongsan Cultural Centre; he also participated in many group exhibitions in Japan and Korea. In 2013, Song received the prestigious 27th Kumbok Cultural Prize from Kumbok Foundation.

宋光翼於 1950 年在韓國首爾出生。宋氏在韓國啟明大學美術學系和美術教育系分別取得學士學位和教育學位後,於日本九州產業大學進修藝術學院進修。他的作品透過在紙張上潑灑或塗上丙烯顏料,展現大自然和歷史。韓紙是由桑樹樹皮造成,這種物料保有風和陽光的能量,更是孕育生命的主要元素。根據觀者的觀賞角度和展覽空間,作品中一層層的漢字轉化成無盡的線和面。他的作品近年曾於韓國首爾 Tong-in Auction Gallery 及 大邱 Bongsan Cultural Centre 展出。宋氏亦曾參與多個日本和韓國的集體展覽。在 2013 年,宋氏獲得最具聲望的昆博克基金頒受昆博克文化獎。
